EXERCISE CARBINGE

(Note: All times and incidents approximate for security purposes)

PHASE 6

09 Mar 96

- 02:30 USS Demeter, USS Geekmobile, USS Tiptoe arr DELPHI. Cdr Goddard arranges sleeping arrangements. Cdr MacGillivray and Ens Lambert proceed to Atlantian Hotel as per prior arrangement. Remainder of crew arranges themselves as per impromptu arrangement. Lt Jacksch and Count Bragg continue verbal sitrep well into the night.
- 09:00 Cdr Goddard awakened by personal alarm, and alarmed by personnel awakened to. Takes cold shower. Suicide attempt by calcium deposit fails miserably. Resigns self to remainder of exercise.
- 09:30-
10:30 Crew wakes variously and/or/plus severally. Showers for everyone. This is the first test. Most personnel surprise Goddard by figuring out how to turn the taps.
- 11:00-
11:30 Somewhere around there, MacGillivray and Lambert arr DELPHI. Crew prepares to dep DELPHI for Buy-More restaurant. Crew dep DELPHI for Buy-More restaurant. Goddard forgets briefcase containing brief. Oelrich follows his duty and Goddard. Briefcase retrieved. Oelrich and Goddard arr Buy-More restaurant after crew.
- 11:30 Breakfast. Ens Morgan arrives by pre-arranged and retroactive surprise. As he will be unable to attend phase 7, PLIGRIM qualification exam is given to him. He writes it with cool, experienced, knowledge in seconds flat.
- 12:13 KON presents OPERATION SINK ME crew with SINK ME decoration in elaborate and highly stylized, though stunningly naturalistic, interpretative dance piece. Onlookers look on. Oelrich shoots everyone. Goddard briefly briefs crew on Phase 7.

PHASE 7

- 13:00 Crew dep Buy-More and embarks. Goddard aboard Demeter. Lambert examines prescribed route to RV Juliet and navs. Tiptoe and Geekmobile follow.
- Later Fleet arr RV Juliet. Lt Robillard leads fleet on security tour of perimeter. Docking at bughouse. Big snowy hill, must slide down. Robillard snags a Niagara Falls souvenir Zippo en route. Crew proceeds up the Funambule to Tower.
- 14:30 Goddard demonstrates the chronologically inconsistent layout of RV Juliet (the emporium). Distributes PLIGRIM qualification exam and golf pencils. Crew goes to work on the questions. Video inoperative, question #14 scratched. Crew hands tests back. Oelrich assembles crew for group photo. Takes photo. Crew waits for Funambule down. Notices absence of Ens Lavictoire. Lavictoire found – was on restroom recce. Group photo #2 taken by security personnel at the back of the elevator. Crew waits for Funambule down. Notices absence of LCdr Yarker and Ms Malley.
- 16:00 LCdr Yarker and Ms Malley arrive – two hours later than planned. Goddard breezes them through

Emporium, accompanied by Oelrich. Remainder of crew sits in a circle. Group photo #3 taken by security personnel at the back of the elevator. Crew waits for Funambule down. Notices absence of Funambule. Funambule arrives. Crew descends inside it.

16:30 Goddard accompanies Yarker and Malley aboard USS Namepending. Yarker and Malley brief Goddard re: success of task in diverting attention of Pepsi Assassins while Fleet en route to RV Juliet.

PHASE 8

17:00 Fleet arr RV Hotel. Ens Clarke and Ms Malley handle vittels. PINHEADS meet in Cdr Goddard's office. Office begins losing oxygen. Meeting begins losing perspective. Bloodshed narrowly averted. Vittels arrive. PINHEADS wrap up and chow down. Jacksch, Bragg, and Yarker entertain with war stories.

19:00 Shore leave declared by Goddard. Yarker and Malley dep for Queenston in USS Namepending. Bobards decided as watering hole. MacGillivray and Lambert decline and dep for Atlantian. Morgan contacted: agrees to join crew shore leave.

Crew leaves Bobards. Pitchers too small and expensive. Couches and free peanuts do not compensate. Oelrich and Lavictoire dep for Byetown in USS Tiptoe. Crew at this point is as follows:

Morgan leads crew to La Cabane, where permanent 2 for 1 is promised. Morgan is wrong. Waitress is cute. Surprisingly, this does not compensate for the lack of other people in the bar. Goddard rendezvouses with Coke Sniper Liaison. Crew departs La Cabane.

Later Crew arrives at Loft – the heretofore secret RV Kilo. Crew drinks further. Rum and Cokes on special. Crew opens dance floor. Jacksch makes initial contact with Montsurreal Coke Sniper Liaison Officers. Drinking and dancing continues. Ens Morgan, Munn and Robillard make further contact with Liaison Officers.

10 Mar 96

03:00 Dance floor and bar close. Morgan, Munn and Robillard nowhere to be seen. Bragg, Goddard, Jacksch and Clarke return to RV Hotel. Lt Robillard waiting in lobby. These five idiots try to get some sleep.

10:00 MacGillivray and Lambert arr RV Hotel. Dep w/Bragg and Clarke in USS Demeter. Still no sign of Munn. Demeter dep RV Hotel.

Event-
ually Munn shows up. Liaison accomplished. Jacksch conducts impromptu and lengthy discussion with Goddard, Robillard and Munn. Showers for Geekmobile crew.

14:00 Geekmobile dep RV Hotel.

16:45 First meal of the day for Goddard.

General Notes:

1. As I believe was sufficiently demonstrated, advance planning is the key to these missions. Particularly advance planning sessions between EIEIO and ORACLE. I recommend more of these, and on a scale befitting the grandeur of OPERATION PLIGRIM.
2. I believe EXERCISE CARBINGE was a qualified success. The multi-purpose task force had more purposes and tasks than foreseen, but they were carried out with class. PLIGRIM exam results speak for themselves. Work on the “rapid” part in “rapid deployment back the fuck out” needs work, particularly on the part of the USS Geekmobile crew.
3. Do I need to say anything more about the success of the surprise mission at RV Kilo? Only that not enough people got it. I cannot overemphasize the importance of this kind of sub-mission – er, extra mission – to the operations of the Slabovian Combined Forces.
4. I am EXTREMELY concerned that CICCUSE did not personally appear at any time during this exercise. One would think he would at least have been present at the SINK ME ceremony. I believe he’s on the verge of losing contact with the rank and file of the SCF. I don’t want to be the one to suggest that he’s neglecting his duties in the grossest and most insulting manner possible, but I do suggest that Count Bragg brief CICCUSE informally as to the responsibilities of the office. Who knows what SHC is going to make of CICCUSE’s virtual – dare I say it? -- dereliction of duty. I didn’t say it! I didn’t say it!

EXERCISE CARBINGE

BORDER CROSSING PROTOCOL

(Note: This protocol has been approved by Coke Snipers, Mtl det. Everything's cool.)
